Each year, we work with hundreds of volunteers to restore natural resources, provide quality environmental education programs, and expand public access opportunities throughout the watershed. Our priorities include:



Educating Youths About the Environment

Each year, more than 1,000 students learn about their role in protecting the natural resources of the watershed through our innovative, science based, environmental education programs. These classroom and field programs are provided free of charge to students and schools located in our 11 watershed communities: Saugus, Lynn, Revere, Malden, Wakefield, Melrose, Everett, Stoneham, Peabody, Lynnfield and Reading.

Protecting and Restoring Our Local Environment

Through river cleanups, scientific research and monitoring, restoration projects, and advocacy, the Saugus River Watershed Council works to protect and restore the rivers, lakes, wetlands and wildlife of the watershed. By working with volunteers, local conservation commissions, businesses, and environmental agencies, the Council monitors development, tracks environmental conditions, and implements actions needed to protect and restore our local natural resources. Our efforts have helped to improve water quality, restore historic fisheries, and protect valuable natural resource areas such as the Rumney Marshes Area of Critical Environmental Concern.



Exploring Natural History

Each year, the Saugus River Watershed Council hosts natural history programs to introduce hundreds of people to the natural beauty, wildlife, and recreational opportunities of the Saugus River watershed. By exploring Rumney Marsh, Lynn Woods, Breakheart Reservation, the Saugus River and other watershed sites, members of the public learn first hand about why protecting our local environment is so important.
