- On November 1, the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) issued a Provisional Decision that would allow Wheelabrator Saugus to dispose an additional estimated 400,000 cubic yards of contaminated ash adjacent to the Rumney Marshes Area of Critical Environmental Concern over the next 5 to 10 years.
- A public hearing will be held on **Thursday, November 30, 2017, 6:30 PM** at the Saugus High School Auditorium, 1 Pierce Memorial Drive in Saugus. Members of the public who are concerned about this expansion are urged to attend the public hearing and submit written comments to DEP to voice their concerns.
